

Cancer In Dogs, What You Can Do To Help Prevent This From Occurring

Let's start by looking at dog food. There is a lot of back and forth about grain free dog food. Today's dog has been domesticated for over 30,000 years. During all that time, “Dog” ate what was made available to them by their humans. Grains are a big part of everyday human life.

So, why the sudden marketing hype about the need for grain free food for dogs? What I have observed with the grain free diets for dogs is an increase in cardiomyopathy. I personally do not use or recommend a grain free diet.

If you are feeding your dog “fresh food” or freeze dried food, good for you. For kibble dog food, I recommend a limited ingredient dog food. A side note, the first five ingredients listed in dog food are the most important and where your attention is needed. DogFoodAdvisor.com is a good reference website.

I use all of these products and my dogs love them! All products have been reviewed and recommended by two veterinarians, one veterinarian with western medicine principals and the second an integrative holistic veterinarian. Other than being a customer, I have no other connections to any of these companies that are linked.

Additionally, when consulting with the integrative medicine (holistic) veterinarian, my dog (diagnosed with cancer) was prescribed Chinese herbs. There were 2 types:
